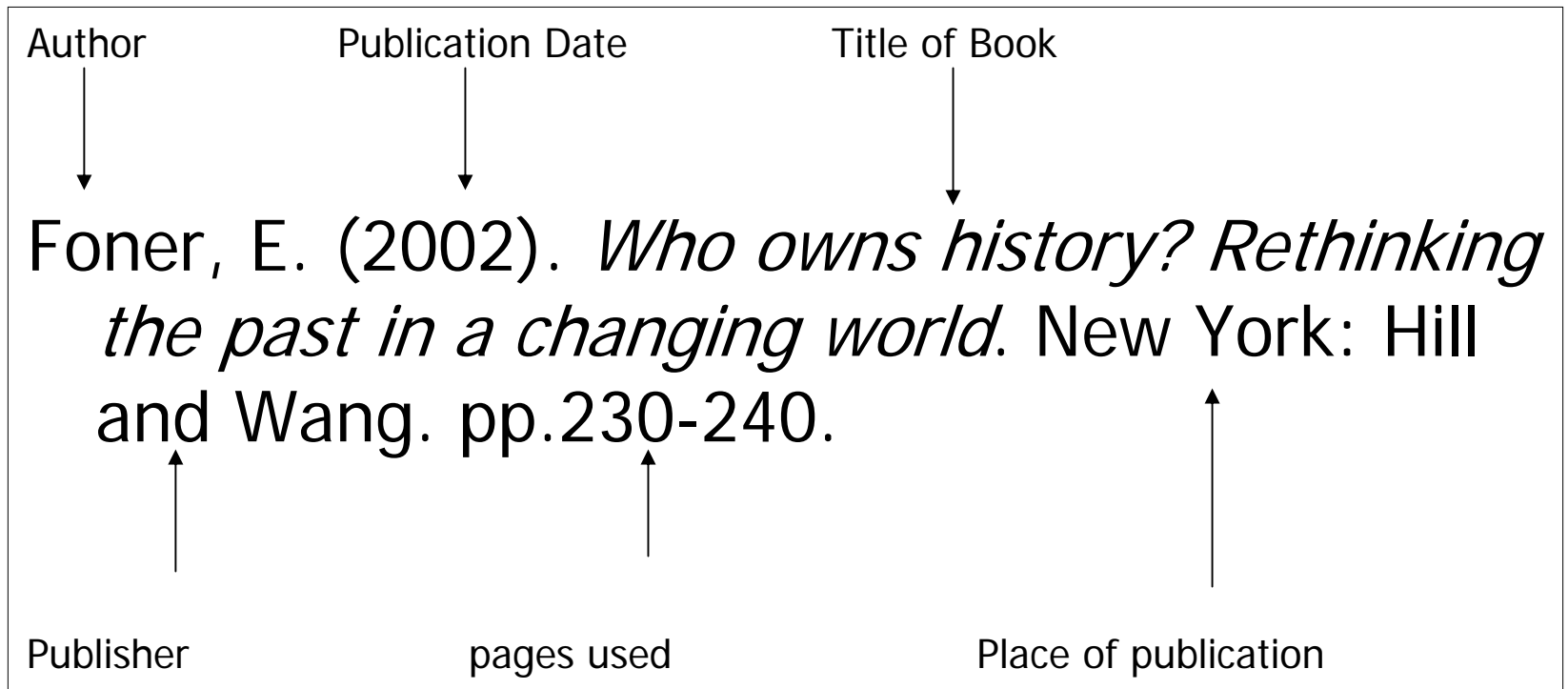

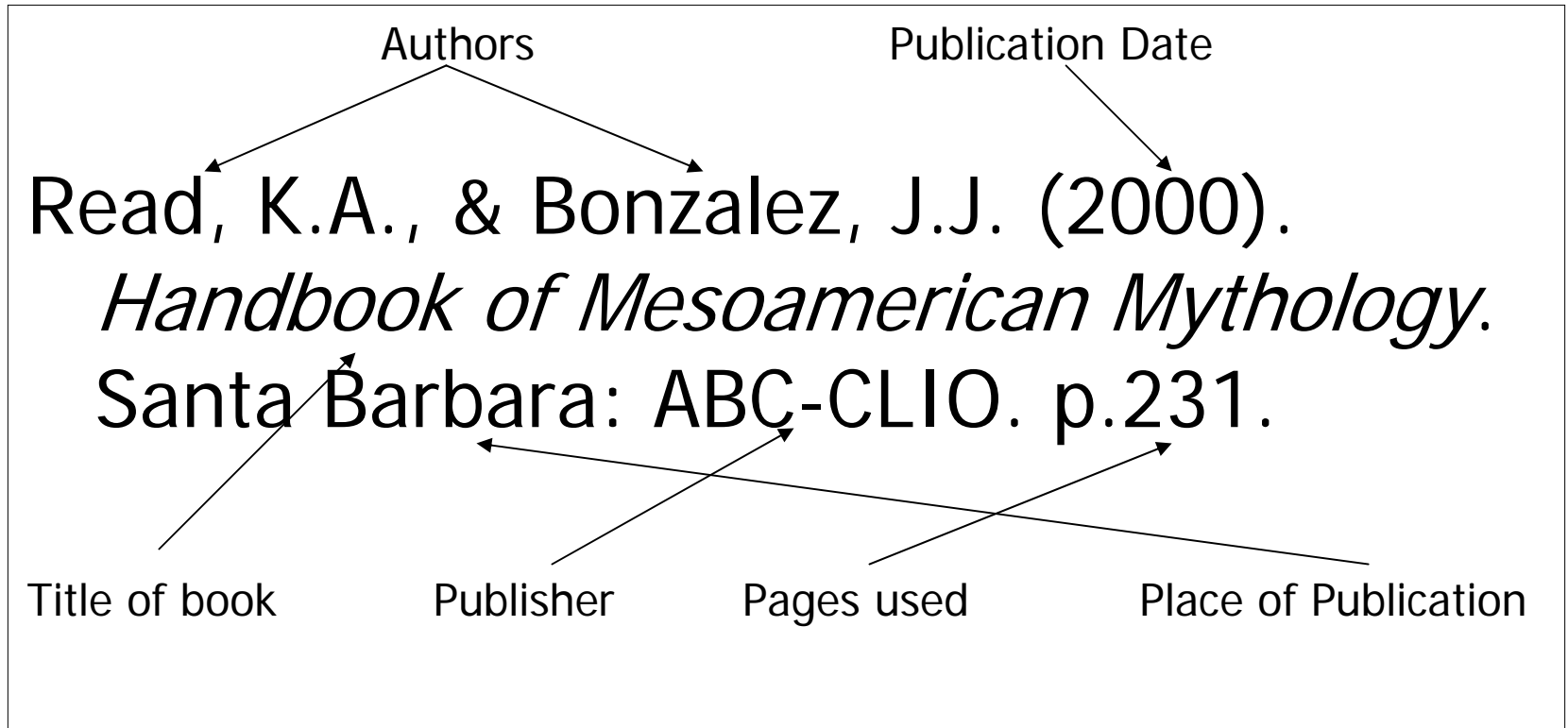

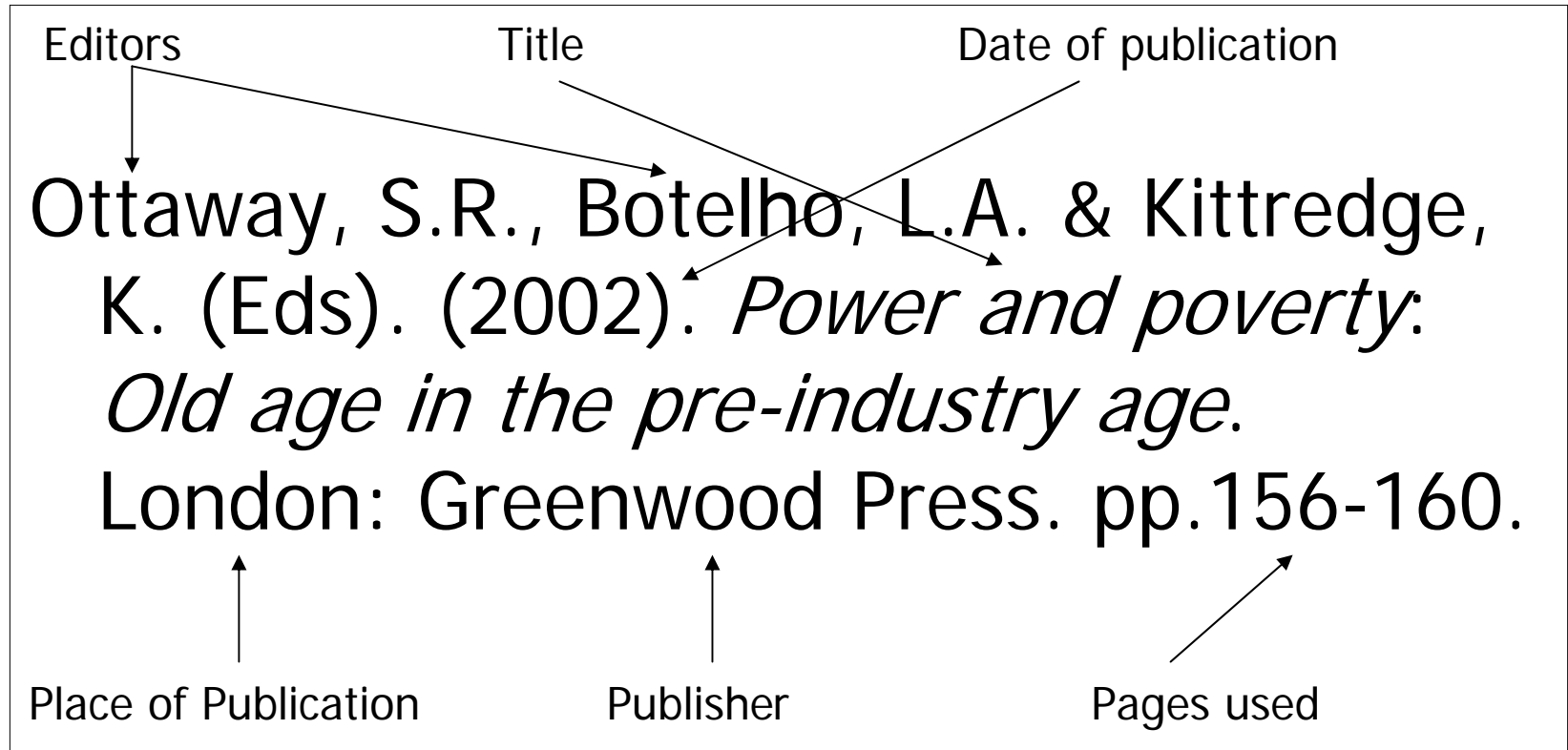
Book (2 authors)

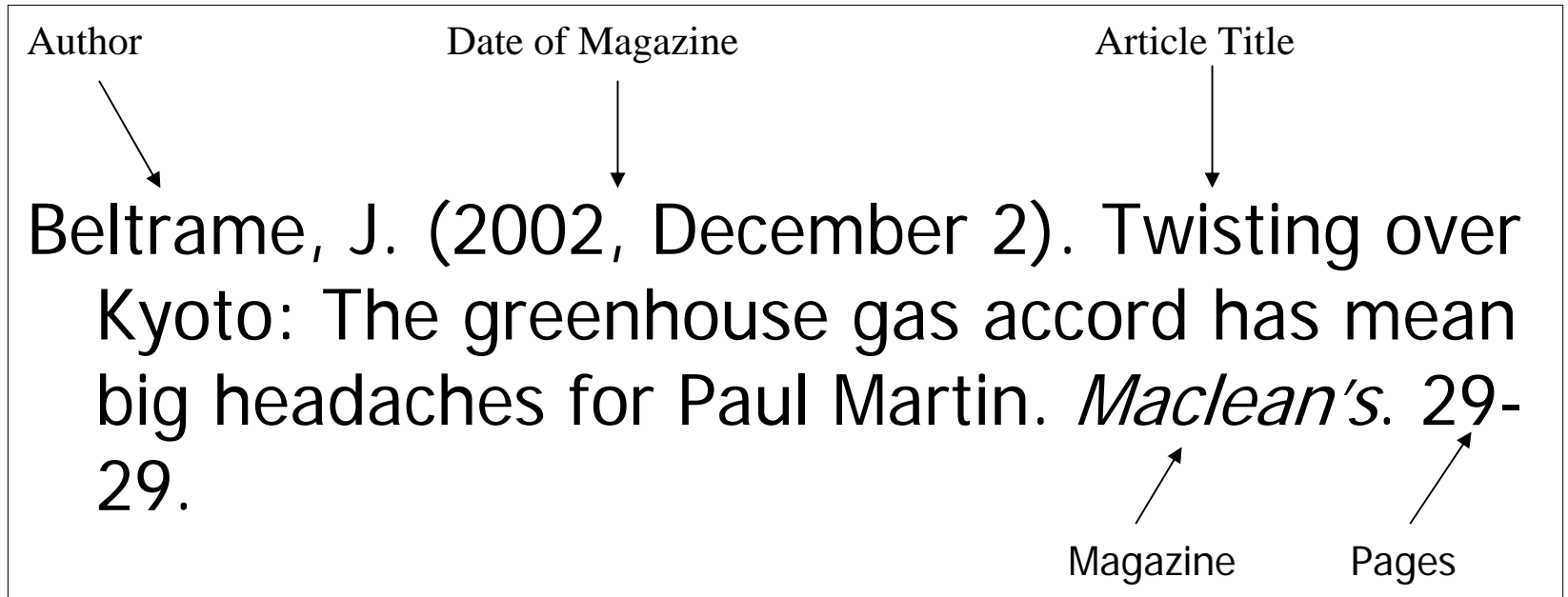
Book (Edited)



No need to include page #s in bibliography if #s are cited in the in-text citation.

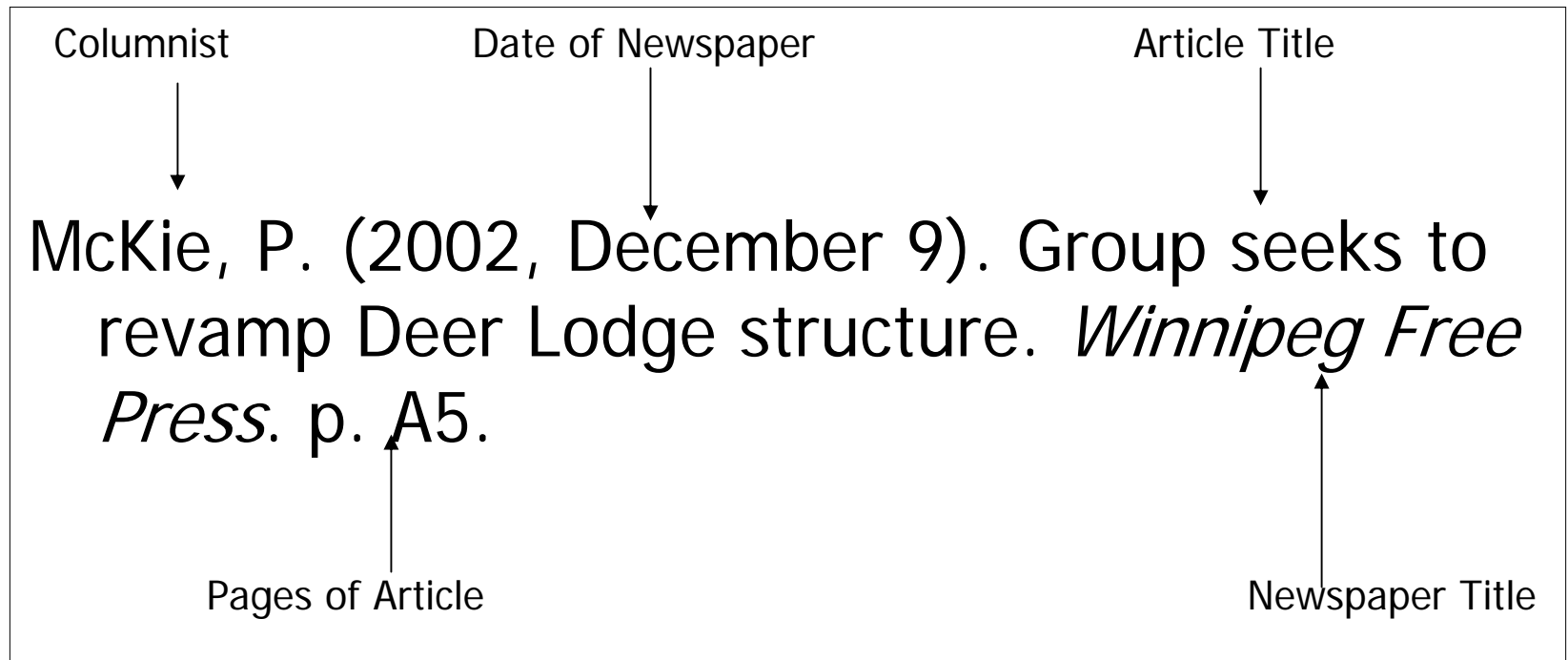

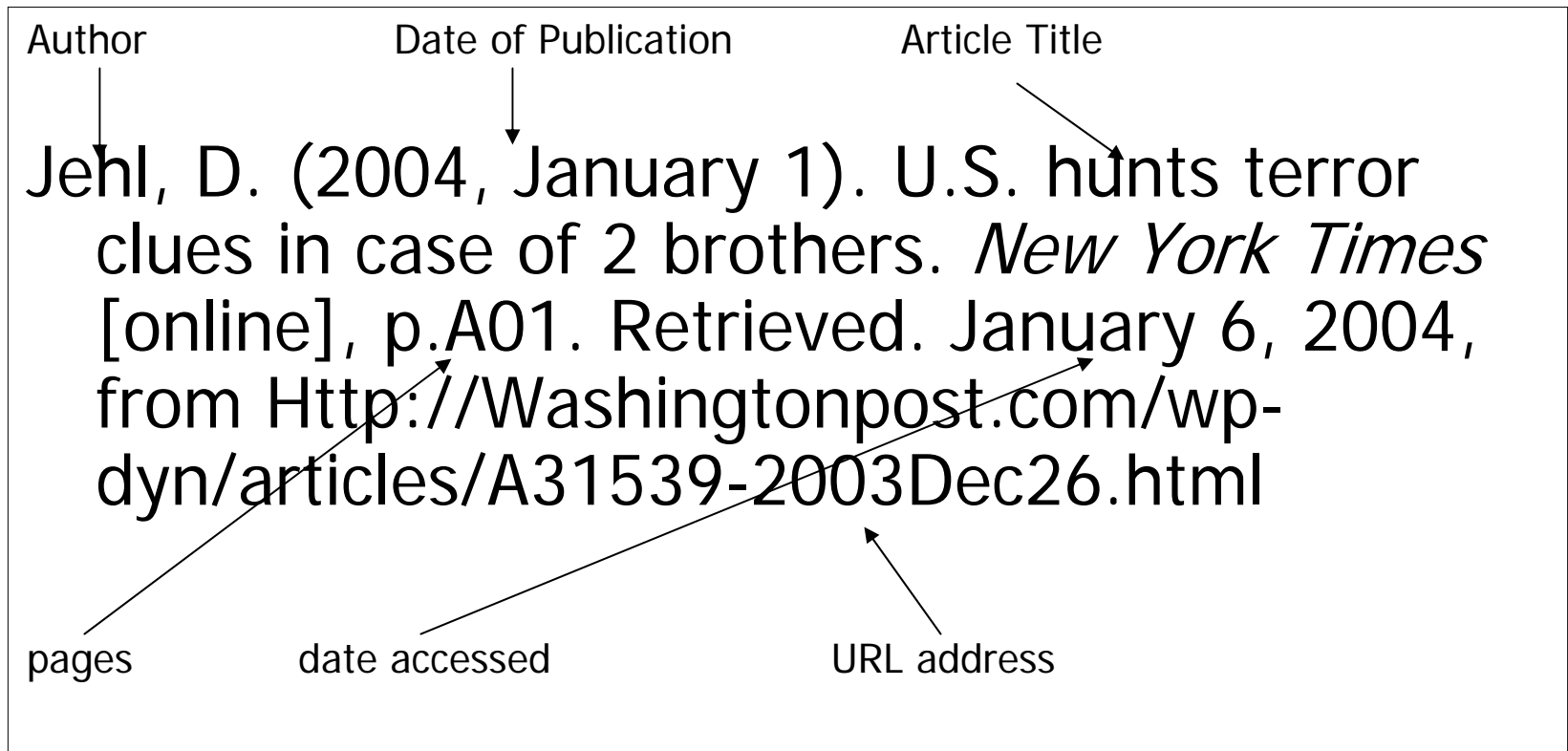
Newspaper Article (print)

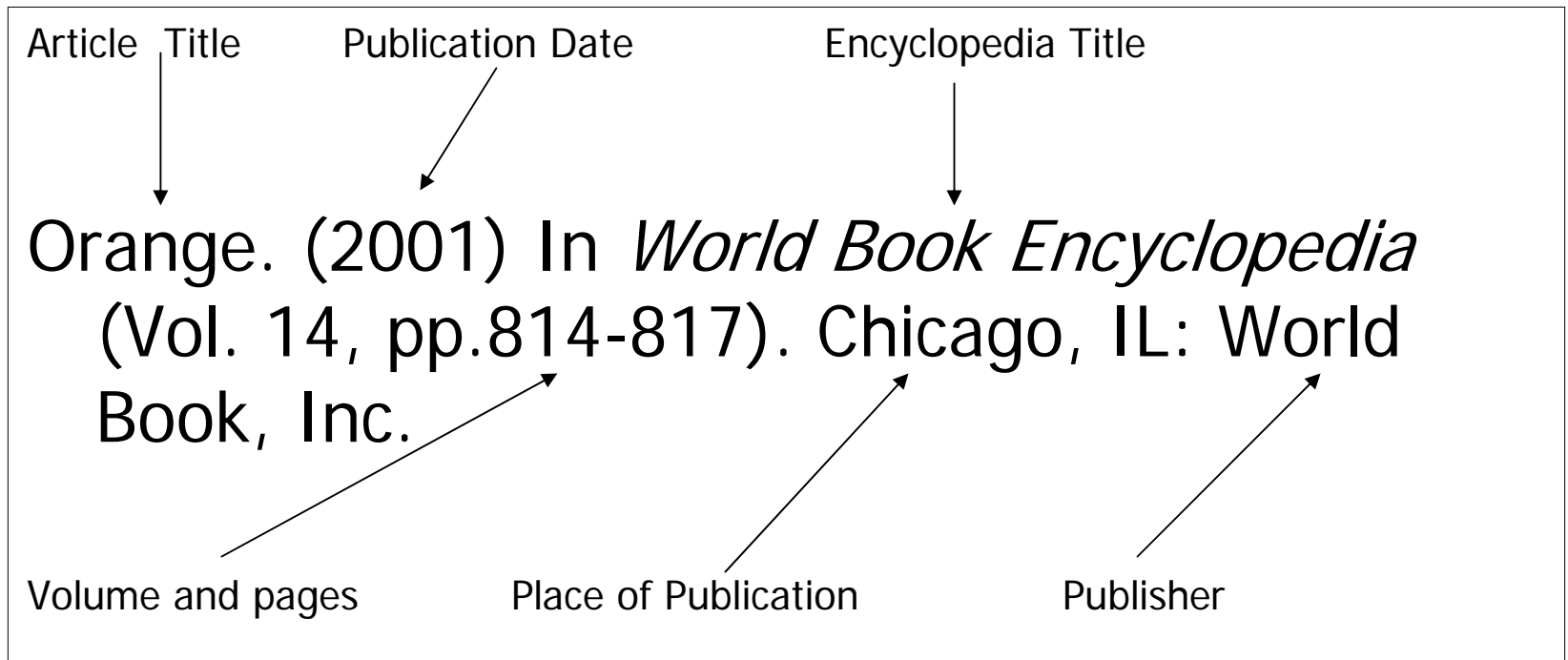

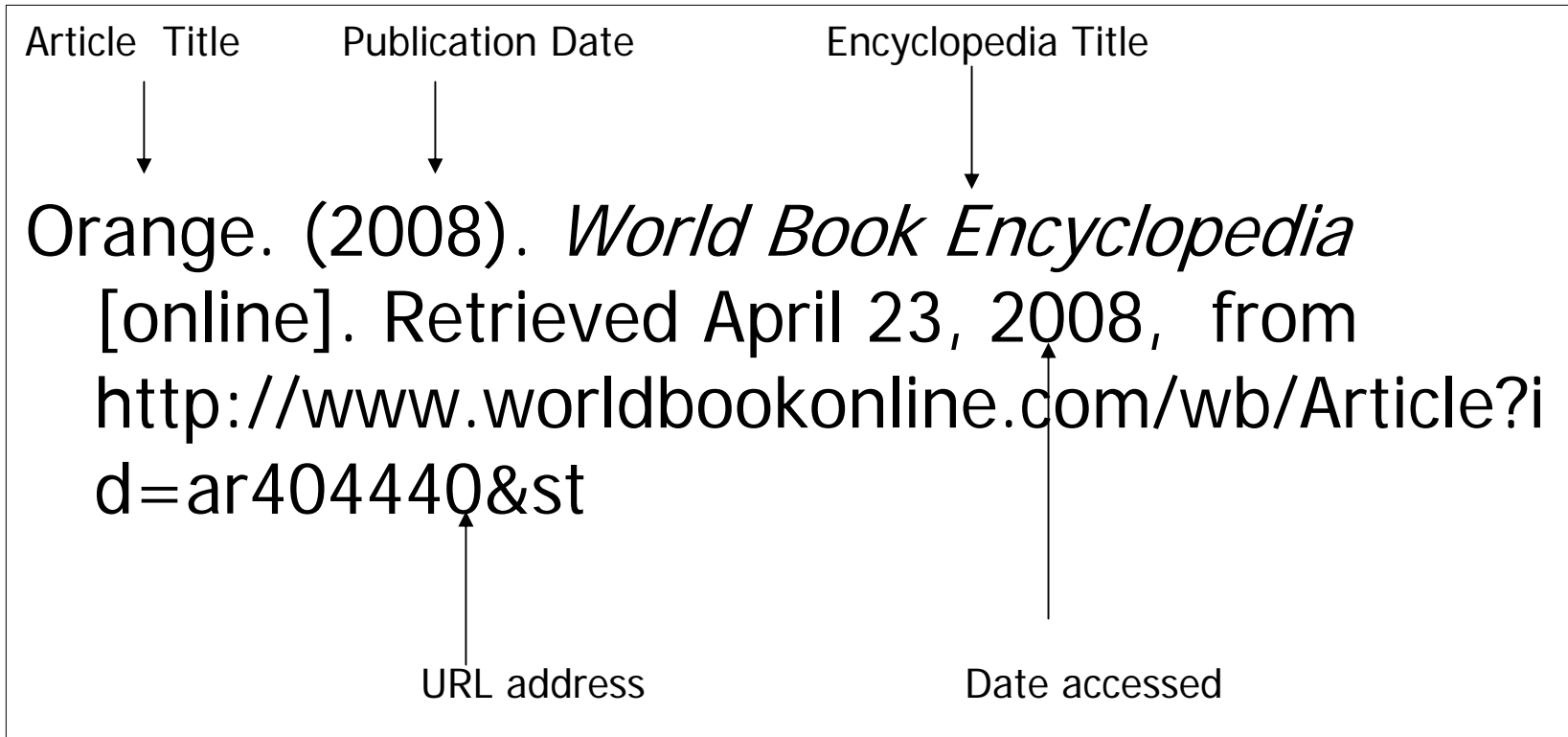

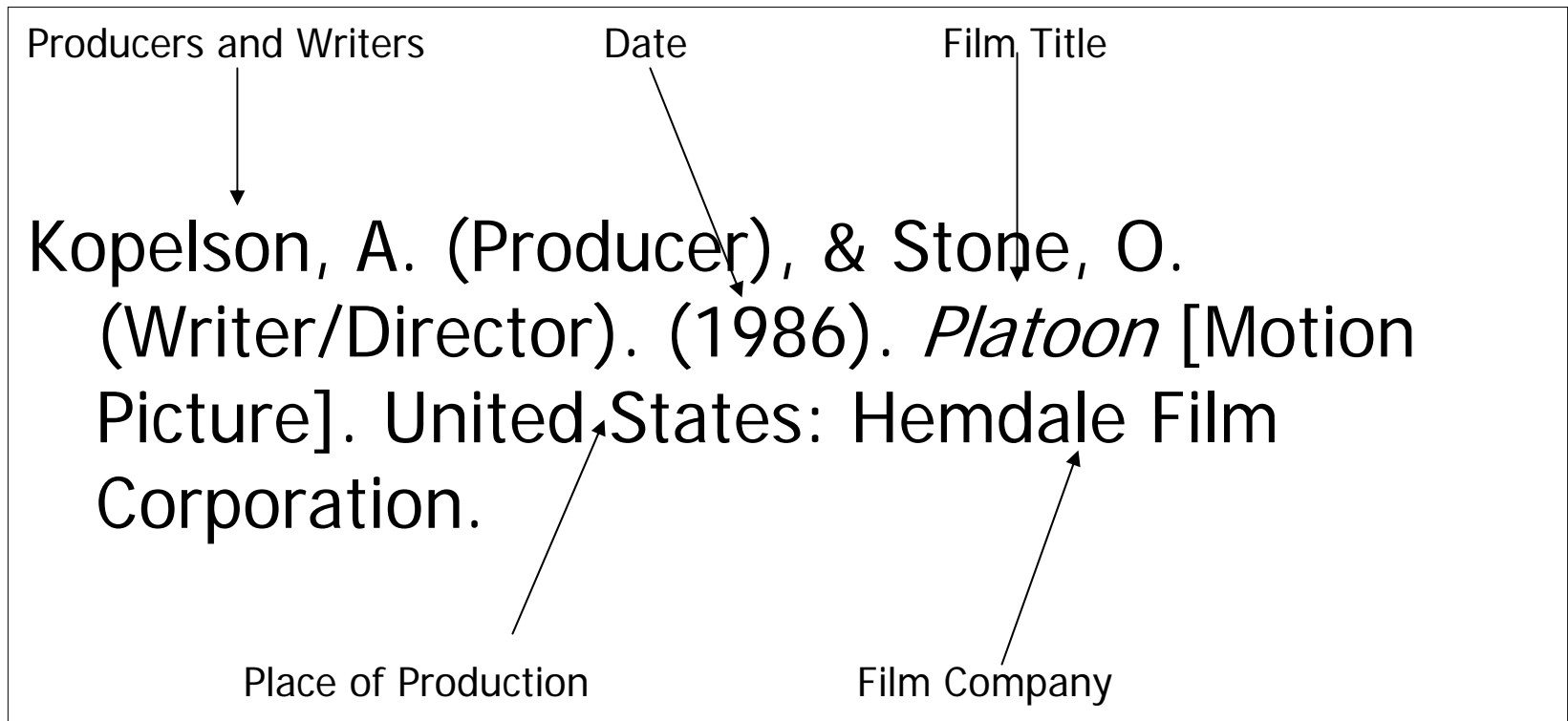
